## Common rules for each sub-jurys

#### **Eligibility**

- ➤ Hold a Master's degree or equivalent
- ➤ Minimum lower second class-honors rating
- > Ranking in the first third of his promotion
- ➤ Agreement of a host team to carry out his thesis

#### **Contest Terms and Conditions**

- > Oral presentation of 10 min
- Questions 15 min

#### How to register

- > Pre-registration with submission of the application file from before 13 May 2024 to the ED.
- ➤ 1 subject only, 1 sub-jury only

#### Composition of the jury

- ➤ 10 14 members :
- ➤ 2 ED Council Members
- > 1 Doctoral student (as an observer)
- > 8 12 experts per sub-jury



### Recruitment procedures

➤ The applications, each associating 1 candidate, 1 project and 1 HDR of a team of the ED62 must be be sent by email before Friday May 13, 2024

- File to be sent to the ED secretariat (<a href="mailto:edsvs-direction@univ-amu.fr">edsvs-direction@univ-amu.fr</a>) as a single PDF file including :
  - 1 Application form (to be downloaded from the ED website)
  - Selection of a sub-jury
  - Competition rules signed by the candidate and the thesis director
  - CV (1 page)
  - Rank of M2 or M1 + S3 (document validated by a Master's supervisor)



### **Oral presentation**

- > Candidates selected for the auditions will have 10 min of oral presentation. This presentation should include :
  - Candidate's background (1 slide)
  - Presentation of a research work in a lab
  - Thesis project
- ➤ This presentation will be followed by a 15-min discussion with the jury. The evaluation will focus on:
  - Feasibility of the project
  - Knowledge of the subject
  - Scientific Maturity



### **ED COMPETITION 2024**

#### January 9 - march 11th

Project submission by the HDRs via ADUM and display after validation

March 18<sup>th</sup> online publication of projects and opening for applications

May 13<sup>th</sup>

Closing of applications

June 19 – 21 : Oral presentation

- Eligibility rules for project leaders:
- Hold an HDR
- Supervise less than 3 full time PhD students FT or 6 part time
- Not having obtained a Doctoral Contract in 2022
- Support only one candidate
- The project must not be submitted to the PhD Programs

- Admission to the competition:
- Rank of M2 or M1 + S3 (document validated by a Master's supervisor)
- Minimum distinction with the lower second-class honors (mention assez bien)
- Submit only one thesis project to the competition
